**Directions for public transportation**

**By bus:**

**Direction Athens → 198 Sygrou ave.:**

The bus station's name in which you should get off is Efesou and is almost 40 meters away from the entrance of the Company. You may reach this station by using one of the following buses:

- 106 (Kolokotroni Sqr. – Saint Barbara)
- 126 (Kolokotroni Sqr. – P. Faliro)
- 134 (Kolokotroni Sqr. – Asirmatos A')
- 135 (Kolokotroni Sqr. – Asirmatos B')
- 136 (Kolokotroni Sqr. – Ano N. Smirni B')
- 137 (Kolokotroni Sqr. – Ano N. Smirni A')
- E22 (Akadimia – Saronida Express)
- 550 (P. Faliro – Kifisia)
- A2 (Akadimia – Voula) via Amfitheas
- B2 (Akadimia – Saint Kosma) via Posidonos ave.

**Direction Peiraias/Glyfada → 198 Sygrou ave.:**

The bus station's name in which you should get off is Efesou and is almost opposite the entrance of the Company. When you reach the bus station you should walk towards the subway which is almost 40 meters away. At the end of the subway is the entrance of the Company. You may reach the bus station Efesou by using one of the following buses:

- 106 (Saint Barbara - Kolokotroni Sqr.)
- 126 (P. Faliro - Kolokotroni Sqr.)
- 550 (P. Faliro – Kifisia)
- E22 (Saronida - Akadimia Express)
- A2 (Akadimia – Voula) via Amfitheas
- B2 (Saint Kosma – Akadimia) via Posidonos ave.

**By Metro:**

In case you choose to visit ING by using the Metro, you have to know that you can use it only for the direction Athens → 198 Sygrou ave., since there are no operating Metro lines to the opposite direction. So, in this case you have to take the red line, to get off at the Metro station Sygrou - Fix and to exit on the surface from the exit Drakou. There, exactly on the road, is a bus station where you can choose one of the above mentioned buses for the specific direction and to get off at the station Efesou, in front of the company.
